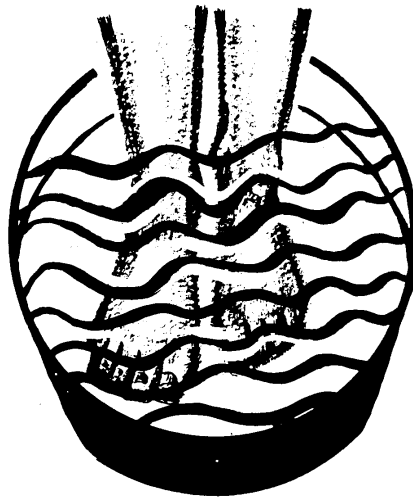

ST ANNE'S SCHOOL OPEN MORNINGS

We are delighted to welcome you to our open mornings at St Anne's Catholic Primary School. Please do come along and experience what makes our school a happy and welcoming place for all.

The open mornings will take place on **Saturday 6th November 2021** and **Wednesday 10th November 2021**.

On **Saturday 6th November**, parents will be able to book a **10am** or **11am** slot for 2 adults per family. Families may bring children on this visit. You will be able to walk around the reception classrooms and meet some of our friendly Reception staff. On **Wednesday 10th November**, parents will be able to book a slot at **10am**, **10:30am** or **11am** (2 adults per family and no children please). Parents will be able to see our children in action. There will be social distancing measures in place to keep the children and our visitors safe. We would like parents to bring masks to school and take a lateral flow test at home before arrival. You will be asked to confirm that you do not have any symptoms linked to COVID-19. All staff involved in the open mornings will have taken a lateral flow test at home on both days and will be wearing masks.
