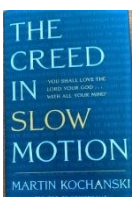

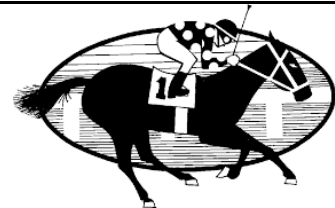
**ARE YOU DEAF OR HARD OF HEARING?**

[Worth Abbey](#) 23-24 October

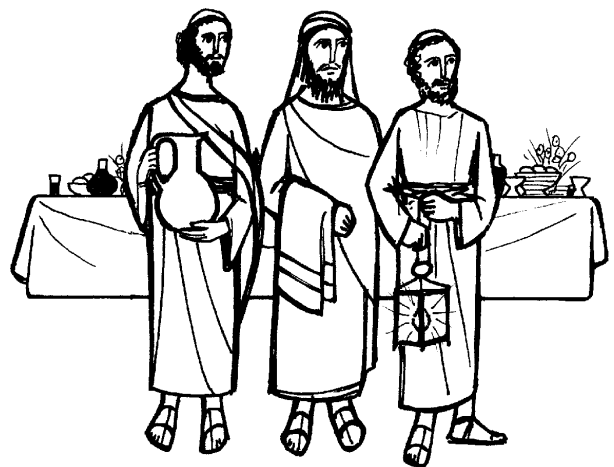
